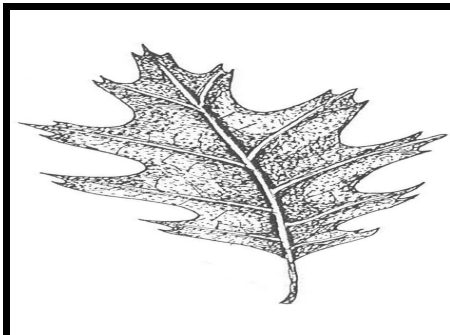
WILDFLOWERS
